#### **2018 Spectrum Offer Details**

The Cambridge Greens 1st Addition Board met June 12, 2018 at 2:00 P.M. One of the items that was addressed under "new business" was Spectrum's offer to provide cable TV and internet service under a five-year contract. The monthly fee of \$60 (estimated at \$72 with tax and fees) does at first seem like a great deal, but the Board has decided not to pursue this offer for the following reasons: The offer is "all or none". It would require all homeowners to participate. No one could opt out. Snowbirds would be required to pay the fee for all 12 months.

Cambridge Greens 1st Addition would become the collection agency for Spectrum. The POA would be obligated to pay Spectrum each month for all homeowners and then collect the individual payments. It may later require additional managing fees. Our yearly dues of \$120 would increase to \$984 (though this could be collected monthly).

As technology changes, the monthly \$72 may be a very bad deal in the future, but we would be obligated for five years.

The final outcome could make a monopoly of cable and internet service within Cambridge Greens 1st Addition. Freedom to choose would be effectively eliminated. If in the future Spectrum offers a different program, we will certainly give it consideration.

#### Special Board of Directors Meeting Was Held on Monday, May 22, 2017

A special BOD meeting was held on May 22nd to count the votes on the proposed amendment for changes to restrictions for out-buildings on vacant lots wherein the owner also owns the house property adjacent to the vacant lot (Article VII, Section 2, Uses and Structures). We received 56 proxies plus there were 10 attendees which = 66 members. This was greater than the 60 needed, so a quorum was established. YES votes were 54, NO votes were 12. Needed to pass was  $2/3 \times 66 = 44$ , so the amendment PASSED.

The amendment will be turned over to our lawyer for recording purposes, but we will be making some revisions to the ACB Guidelines to reflect the changes in the amendment immediately. The BOD will take future actions in accordance with the amendment.

#### Natural Gas Project Update, 1 September 2009

As was noted in a letter sent out to the membership on August 21, 2009, the natural gas extension project that the Board of Directors has been working on this past year had to be put on hold for at least a year. Central Florida Gas Company informed the Board that due to financial circumstances resulting from a recent merger with another company, they would not be able to fund any additional neighborhood capitol investments, e.g., pipeline extensions at this time. Their best estimate was that it could be 1-2 years before the situation could sufficiently change to make this a viable project for them. The Board will continue to monitor the status through coordination with Central Florida Gas and reinstitute the project at the earliest practical date.

#### Seminar on Collections and Foreclosures, August 7, 2009

Buzz Fredrickson, POA President, and Paul Simek, our ACB Chairman, represented Cambridge Greens 1 at this seminar. Bob Tankel, an attorney from Dunedin, Florida was the quest speaker. Bob talked to the importance of the collection process for homeowner associations and the need to adopt a uniform and timely process for insuring that owners comply. For those that do become delinguent, friendly reminders should be sent prior to a warning that the account will be subject to lien and ultimate foreclosure through the legal process. In 2007, the Florida legislature modified the steps that a POA must follow in order to properly collect unpaid assessments that has added about 120 days to the process. Given the lengthy legal process in pursuing foreclosures, Bob emphasized the need to get started as soon as possible. He emphasized the fact that pursuing a foreclosure does not in any way obligate the POA to assume any mortgage responsibility. Bob talked through the legal process for filing liens and foreclosures and noted that his policy is to collect legal fees from the delinquent owner at the time of settlement without imposing any fees on the POA in the interim. We have had firsthand experience in that regard in that Bob was our attorney for a recent foreclosure settlement. #### Natural Gas Project Meeting, May 20, 2009

This was a meeting with Darrell Reneau, the TECO representative, regarding the current status and future schedule to provide gas service to our community. Darrell advised the cost analysis data and joint agreement with our POA were in final stages of legal review and would be available to POA members prior to our next Board meeting on June 17th, 2009. In fact, a follow-on meeting with Darrell was arranged for June 15th to go over these documents prior to the Board meeting. TECO has reviewed our draft deed restriction relative to gas service for future POA home construction and found it to be a good definition of agreed requirements found within the joint agreement. The Board objective will be to submit all project documentation to Mr. Tankle for legal review on our behalf before sending the deed restriction out for approval. Longer-range planning is to have a fully approved project ready for construction beginning this fall.

#### 2009 Cambridge Greens 1 POA Annual Meeting Was Held on Sunday, February 22

#### Gas Line Extension Letter and Questionnaire Mailed to POA Members

This past summer, your Board of Directors initiated an investigation into the feasibility of extending natural gas lines into our community. TECO Energy undertook a cost analysis of this project and briefed the Board on the results at our November Board of Directors meeting. Basically, they found that this effort could be undertaken with minimal risk but that the gas company contract with the POA would dictate some minimum hookup standards subject to financial penalties if not met. A Gas Line Extension Letter and Questionnaire have been mailed out to all members of Cambridge Greens 1st Addition detailing this effort. While the Board feels an extension of the gas pipeline is a good option, we are truly interested in getting membership feedback before proceeding. Please fill out the questionnaire and return it at your earliest convenience to the address indicated on the form.

#### Status of Gas Service Availability for Cambridge Greens 1st Addition

A special session of the Board was called to hear the results of the gas company's analysis into extending natural gas lines into our community and to approve our budget for 2009. Mr. Darrell Reneau gave the Board a thorough briefing on the study he performed and a copy of the draft contract that would have to be approved before the company could proceed.
